Boylston Elementary and Berlin Memorial Schools participated in National Inclusive Schools Week (NISW) having the students fill out gift tags showing their special gifts they bring to the school and community. These were displayed in the main hallways of both schools.

Christi Stille reports that the Tahanto Middle School's HOPE Club lead the activities during NISW. The HOPE Club's adviser Danielle Gardner explains the events for the week included a poster contest with the theme "What does inclusion look like at Tahanto?" The winners and participants can be seen in a display on the wall near the main office area.
